Free Admission

- Children under the age of 6 Disability ID Card holders (any accompanying person must be indicated on the card)
- Teachers accompanying school groups (free entrance for 1 person accompanying a group of 15 pupils)
- Licenced EU guides with clients holding purchased tickets to castle buildings
- Free admission or discounts are provided only upon presentation of an official document proving the eligibility for the respective benefit. For students, this would be a valid student ID card or a proof of full-time study. For groups: upon presentation of the list of names of primary, secondary school/university students certified by the school (with a stamp + signature). School groups: min. 10 persons.
- Tour leaders, drivers or other support staff accompanying a group are not entitled to a reduced entrance fee.
- · Licenced EU guides must provide a valid guide licence at the entrance to Castle buildings.
- Admission to one-off exhibitions and concerts is established independently.
- Prague Castle Administration reserves the right to close historical buildings of Prague Castle or the whole Castle area due to operational or state-ceremonial reasons.
